Interim Results- working towards our targets

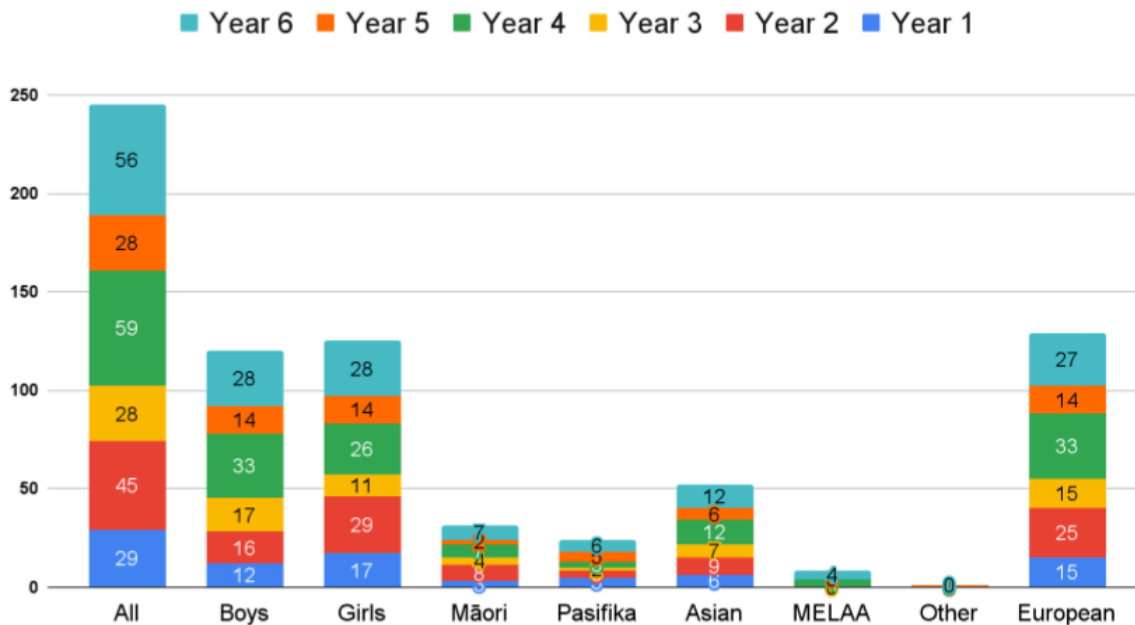
The Syndicate Summaries give the Board to see how we are tracking against our targets at the INTERIM or half way mark.

We are really pleased with the results presented. We liked the attendance % in this report so we can get a clear idea of interventions we can support as a board.

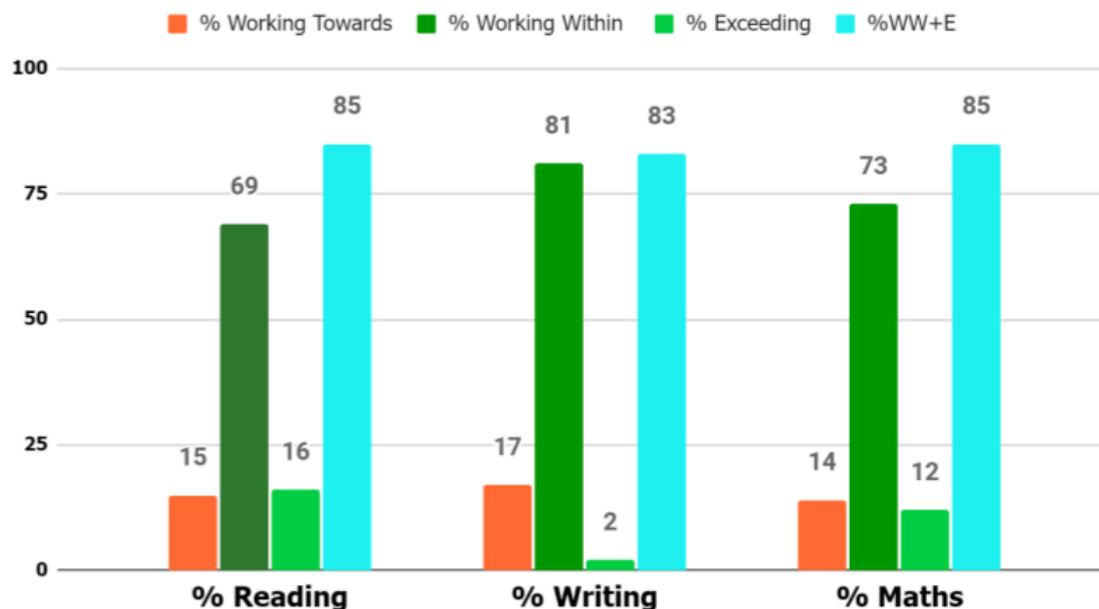
Please note: Where there are only a small cohort of a particular set of students we will not report in any identifying way. Issues around privacy are important to us.

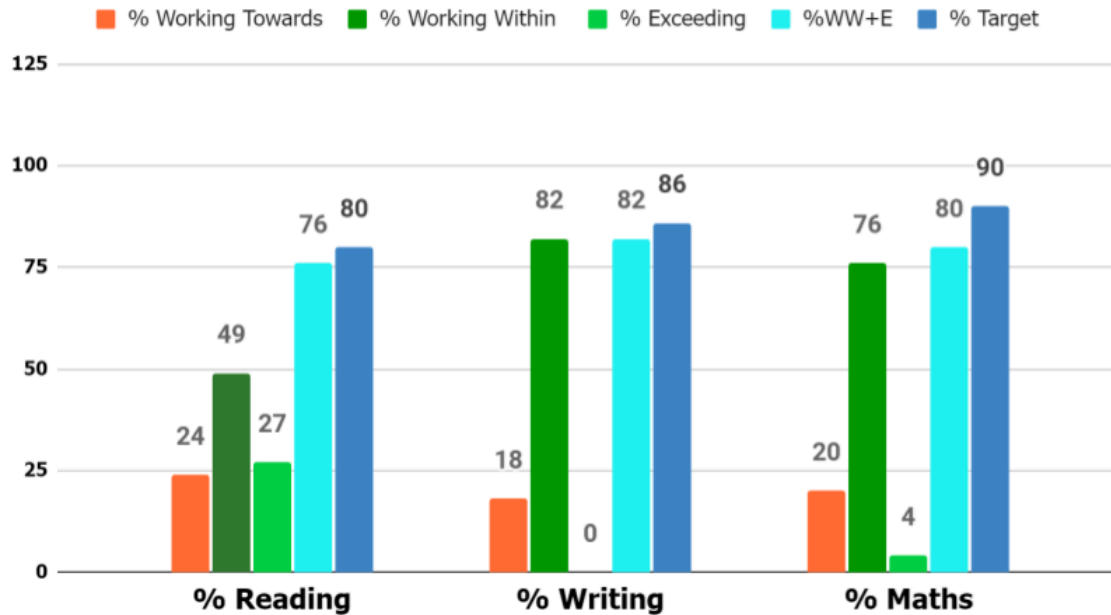

Summary:

We have not yet reached the targets at interim. Comparing to EOY 2023 there are improvements for reading and writing. Overall, the progress and results are pleasing, despite a couple of high needs students, disruption from moving classes and 3 new students to the school who are below (6%). We have got 2 fabulous teacher aides and a fantastic teaching team working together for all these students. ELL work is underway every day with a TA. Year 1 achievement is exceeding the targets in Reading, Writing and Maths. **Next steps** - look at maths at Year 2 and keep this as a focus, whether we continue with structured maths. Look at what to do for Tier 2 students for BSLA.

Summary:

Overall our year 4 cohort have made consistent progress, maintaining achievement and progress similar to the EOY data in 2023. We have had two year 4 students leave who were working within for all 3 key areas. We have 3 new students who have enrolled this year, two of whom are working towards for literacy and numeracy.

Actions and next steps:

Deep dive into our ELL achievement. Monitor our year 4 children who have been on the BSLA programme, has this made an impact? This is our syndicate goal, how can BSLA program raise achievement for our targeted children?

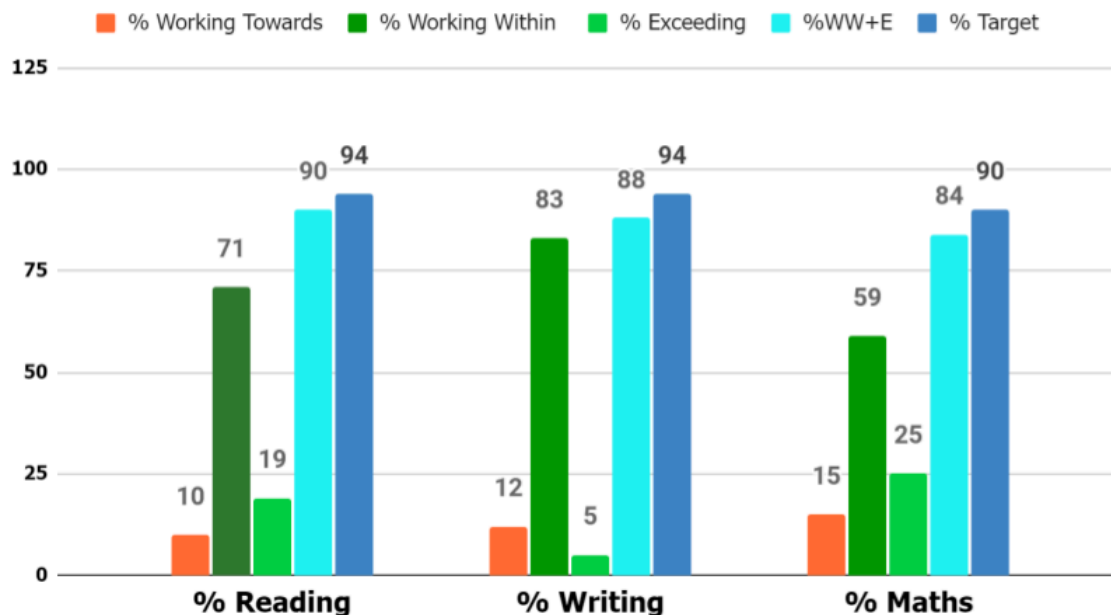

Summary:

Progress has been made against the 2023 achievement results however we are aware that not all progress is consistently linear. There are targeted students in each class who will need to continue to make accelerated progress in order to be achieving at the end of the year which is challenging. We had 1 new Year 6 student at the start of the year (ELL) and 1 achieving student leave this term.

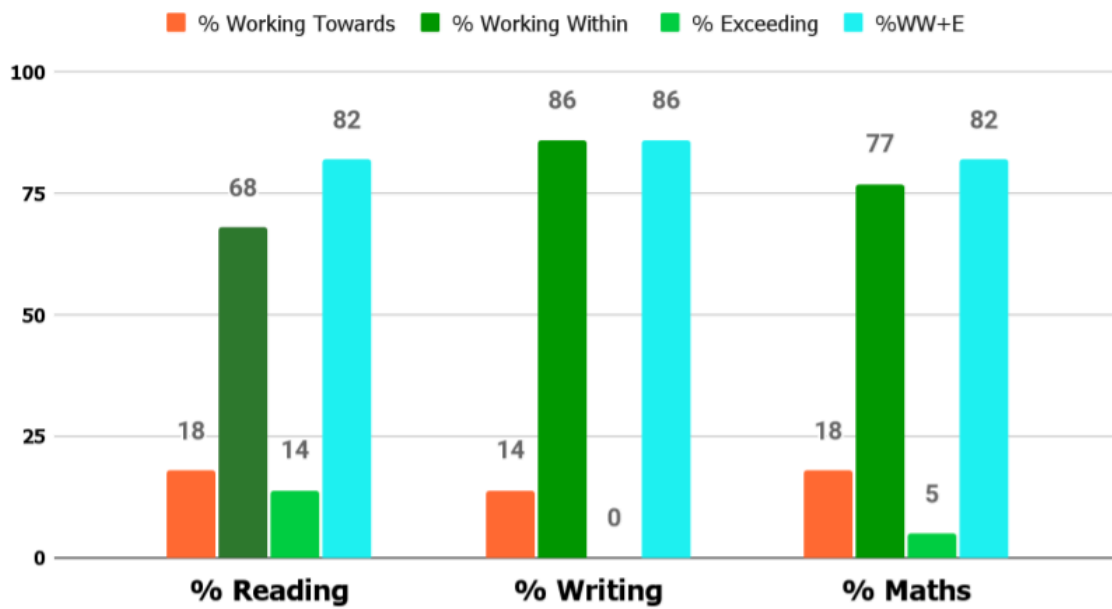
Next steps:
